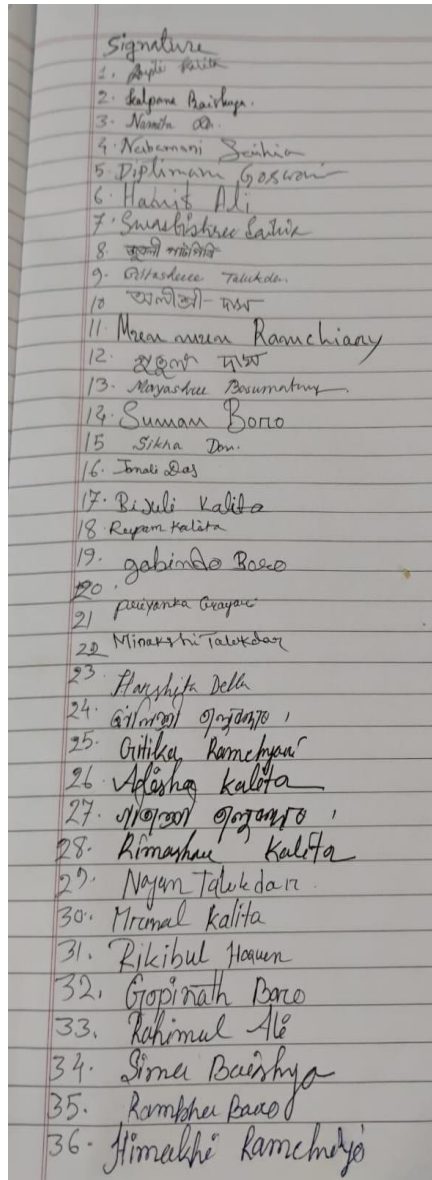
Health Awareness Programme for Women

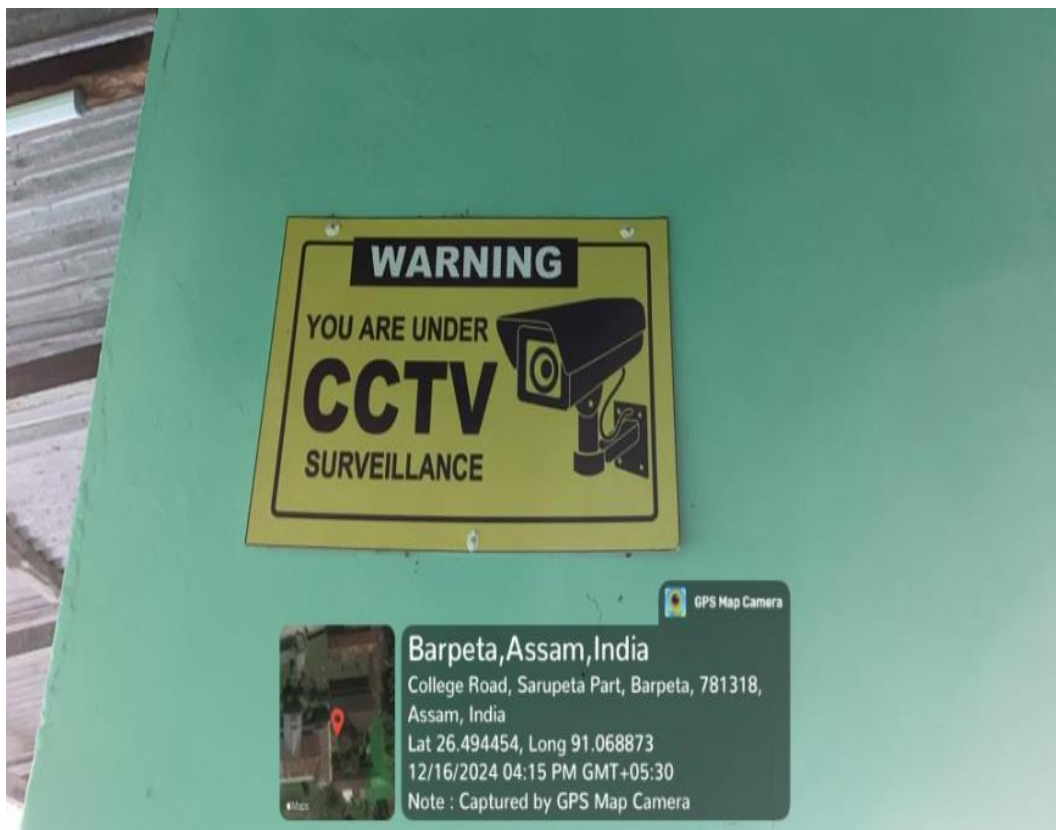
