The Fund Mobilisation Policy outlines the following:

- The Governing body monitors the optimal utilisation of the funds for the smooth functioning of the institution.
- The Budget and Planning Committee prepares the Annual budget before the commencement of every academic year and that budget is placed before the Governing Body and once it is approved by the Governing Body, it is executed as per the procurement policy of the Government.
- The student related fund is maintained separately under various heads i.e., Union Fund, College
 Magazine Fund, Cultural etc. and allocation of fund head-wise is provided separately before the
 commencement of every academic year and the expenditure is met on recommendation of the Incharges of various heads related to the student related fund.
- The Principal on approval of the Governing Body and Purchasing and Utilisation sub-committee manages the fund for procurement, supply and installation maintaining the Government guidelines on procurement.
- The income and expenditure of the college is in accordance with the annual budget.
- The local audit is performed annually by Government Auditor/Chartered Accountant.
- The College provides financial supports to faculty members to attend seminars/workshops/expert talks/Association activities/Faculty Development programmes
- Scholarships and free ships are provided to eligible students
- Resources for fund mobilisation are: Tuition Fee, Examination Fee, Hostel Fee, Admission Fee, Centre fee from Institutions, fee collected from students who are enrolled into self-financing courses and fisheries, selling of e-waste, unused land of the college is put on lease for agricultural produce, selling of manure from vermicompost pit.
