This understanding witnesses the following:

1. Where as a party B.H.B College, Sarupeta, (1<sup>st</sup> party) proposes for training and internship services of eligible students under Government Livestock Farm, Barapetta. The first party will provide eligible candidate for placement and livestock farming internship. Whereas the 2<sup>nd</sup> party sends the 1<sup>st</sup> party the requisition list to be placed at their establishment and when they receive the recommendation letter from the 1<sup>st</sup> party. The 2<sup>nd</sup> party will do the needful for their placement in different categories.

Also, the 2<sup>nd</sup> party will place the required member of students for livestock farming internship; the 1<sup>st</sup> party will recommend the same to the 2<sup>nd</sup> party as when needed for the internship under different categories. Whereas the party has desired and agreed to provide required assistance, the details of which are mentioned below, in this regard to the 1<sup>st</sup> party for smooth conduct of the placement service and livestock farming internship program as per the following terms and conditions.

1. It is agreed that the 2<sup>nd</sup> party will provide resource person, required materials for livestock farming internship program to the 1<sup>st</sup> party.

- 2. The 1<sup>st</sup> party faculty with the help of the 2<sup>nd</sup> party will motivate students to take up the livestock farming Internship program.
- 3. This arrangement will be responsibility sharing basis between the 1<sup>st</sup> party and the 2<sup>nd</sup> party as follows. The roles and responsibilities of the 1<sup>st</sup> party and the 2<sup>nd</sup> party are spelt out below:
- 4. Responsibilities of B.H.B. College Sarupeta (herein after references to as the 1st Party)
- 4.1.1; 1<sup>st</sup> party will provide the detailed list of students for livestock farming internship program as and when needed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> party.
- 4.1.2; 1<sup>st</sup> party will provide the recommendation for placement of students soon after the receipt of the requirement for the same.
- 4.1.3; The 1<sup>st</sup> party will recommend the names of student for livestock farming internship Programme along with the name of job placement as per the norms and procedure laid down by the 1<sup>st</sup> party.

Responsibilities of Government Livestock Farm, Barapetta (herein after referred to as the 2<sup>nd</sup> Party)

- 4.2.1; The 2<sup>nd</sup> party will provide instructors for livestock farming internship programme as per requirement to help the instructors belonging to the 1<sup>st</sup> party.
- **4.2.2;** The 2<sup>nd</sup> party will provide materials when necessary for taking livestock farming internship programme.
- 4.2.3.; The 2<sup>nd</sup> party will help the 1<sup>st</sup> party in motivating the students for livestock farming programme.

## Report on Lecture Session on Cattle Farming and the Importance of Artificial Insemination

Date of Event: 22nd November 2023

Venue: Digital Seminar Hall, B.H.B. College, Sarupeta

Resource Person: Dr. Pradip Kumar Baishya, Farm Manager, Govt. Farm Barapetta

On 22nd November 2023, B.H.B. College, Sarupeta, and Government Livestock Farm, Barapetta organized a lecture session on *Cattle Farming and the Importance of Artificial Insemination* at the Digital Seminar Hall. The session was conducted by Dr. Pradip Kumar Baishya, a Farm Manager from the Government Farm Barapetta, whose extensive experience in cattle farming and artificial insemination made him a valuable resource person for the event.

This method, according to Dr. Baishya, helps overcome the challenges of breeding in remote areas where access to high-quality bulls may be limited.


Dr. Baishya also discussed the technical aspects of AI, including the process of collecting, storing, and inseminating the cattle with semen. He explained that the success of AI largely depends on proper timing and techniques, such as detecting estrus in cows and using the correct handling and storage methods for semen. Furthermore, the lecture covered the role of **extension services and government schemes** that promote the adoption of AI among farmers. Dr. Baishya encouraged the participants to utilize these resources to improve their farming practices and increase their economic returns. The lecture was interactive, with Dr. Baishya answering several questions from the audience, addressing concerns related to AI's practical challenges, and providing valuable insights on improving cattle farming techniques. His extensive knowledge and experience were appreciated by all attendees.
