- 2.2. First party and Second party's cooperation will facilitate effective utilisation of the intellectual and farming capabilities.

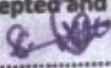

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

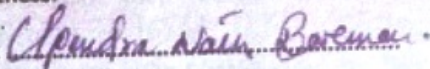
- 3.1. The Terms of the MOU will be of Three years from the date of signing the Agreement.

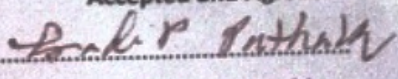

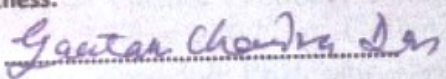

Report on One-Day Workshop on Organic Farming

On September 8, 2023, IQAC, B.H.B. College, Sarupeta, organized a one-day workshop on Organic Farming, aimed at raising awareness about sustainable agricultural practices and encouraging the adoption of organic farming techniques. 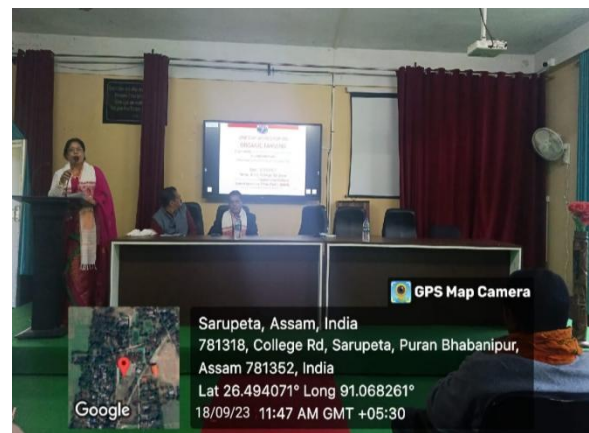
Session Overview:
