CLAUSE 3

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 3.1. The Terms of the MOU will be of Three years from the date of signing the Agreement
- 3.2. The First Party will bear its own costs and expenses for the service rendered by the second Party.
- 3.3. This MOU is non-exclusive. No third party may enter between them.
- 3.4. Payment by the Second Party must be made within months by Cash/Cheque/DD in favour of S.S. Technologies.
- 3.5. If the First Party is not satisfied during the 1st quarter after entering the agreement, the said contract could be discontinued and/or the due payment may be stopped at their sole discretion.
- 3.6. The service engineer will visit monthly for routine check up of the computers and peripherals besides regular servicing.
- 3.7. 100% payment after successful installation and completion of training to the staff of the hoist institution.
- 3.8. The complete installation shall be subject to checks at all stages and test and the service provider shall be liable to rectify any defects as brought out by the hoist institution.
